We are seven weeks into studying the Gospel of John. What has stood out to you? What has impacted you so far?

"I am the bread that came down from heaven." (6:31-41) This is in reference to manna given to the Israelites in the desert. Read about it in **Exodus 16:12-16, 31**, and **Deuteronomy 8:1-3.** What parallels and lessons can you come up with comparing Jesus and manna?

It doesn't seem like people would have a problem with manna, but in time some did (**Numbers 11:4-10**). Why are we sometimes resistant to the good things God provides? How can you avoid this?

God is tugging at hearts today, even yours. He wants you to draw close and receive the full and abundant life Jesus came to give you. Where is your resistance to God's pull?

Confess your resistance, and open yourself up to what God has for you in Christ.

Prayer:

Jesus, I believe that you are the Son of God, the Messiah, and the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. Forgive me when I take your blessings for granted, hold onto what you want me to let go, and fail to follow your ways. Thank you for providing all my soul needs, and walking with me in this life. In the good and the bad I receive you as my Savior, Lord and Friend. Amen.
