## Pray for Your Country — 1 Timothy 2:1-8

 2:1. Pray with urgency, making it a priority. "I urge, then, first of all..."

How?

- 2:1-2. Don't be partial.
   Consider the needs of all, including those in authority. "for all people ...and all those in authority"
- 2:3. Be confident that prayers like this "are good and pleasing to God our Savior."
- 2:8. Join with others whenever you can. "everywhere"

2:9. Pray, seeking a right relationship with God and no anger or disputing.

- 2:2. "that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness."
- 2. 2:3-6. Pray that all people will be saved and come to a knowledge of the truth" Truth based on the fact "that there is one God and one mediator between God and man, the man Christ Jesus."
