

- NORTHEAST INDIA. Pastor Steward rejoices that we are in Christ no matter if life has landed in suffering. He writes to remind us that Hebrews 12 encourages us to FIX our eyes on Jesus. He reports that Christians are facing increasing hostility from Hindutva nationalism. At the same time,

people continue to come to Christ and we are always asked to lift up these new believers in prayer. So, Steward seeks continued prayer for their ministry in villages, the village school, and at the Bible Training Center; and for Manipur because



many believers are suffering in relief camps. Flooding continues in Assam where Steward is and several of his colleagues and students are sick and in need of prayer. Finally, let's pray for his family's health and that his daughter, Somiwon, would be admitted to a good university.
