**We seek God's help for TEACHERS, that they may...**

- Be wise in preparation (content, time management, various delivery methods)
- Be as discerning and gracious as possible toward all students (including those struggling with content, those with poor attitudes concerning their own life and worth, and those who are disobedient or disrespectful)
- Handle stress in a godly manner in and out of the classroom
- Choose to be a Christ-like example to the children under their care
- Stay in good health and maintain enthusiasm throughout many months of their great effort to do a good job
- Be ambassadors of Christ wherever they are, reflecting Christ's gentleness and humility and His commitment to truth

**We seek God's help for ADMINISTRATORS & SUPPORT STAFF (cafeteria, transportation, office, paraprofessionals, counselors, medical, maintenance, custodial, safety officers), that they may...**

- Be aware of the necessity and importance of their positions – often the first person with whom students, staff and the public interact
- Maintain God-honoring relationships with students and have His wisdom in dealing with difficult situations
- Be patience with all types of constituents, staying calm under pressure
- Be wise related to building use, curriculum and scheduling of classes
- Maintain health and safety (general building safety, management of student population, safety on the road, healthy environments)
- Respect authority of the school board, other administrators, the legislature, and Department of Education
- Communicate often and well, wisely seeking to clarify confusion and resolve conflicts in God-honoring ways
- Show compassion for school families and the hurting

**We seek God's help for COACHES, that they may:**

- Prepare their team to compete at the highest level of sportmanship
- Balance a desire to win with doing the best for every child
- Honor Christ in winning and defeat, showing resilience and teachability in all situations, remaining God-honoring under pressure.
- Be wise in decisions regarding athlete's health
- Practice safety in transportation, competition, and practice for their team
